4th June

The two day **Lavender Festival** was celebrated in **Jammu and Kashmir's, Bhadarwah Valley**. The Bhadarwah Valley is now known as the '**lavender capital of India**'. This is because lavender is grown there in large quantities. The festival was organised by the **Council of Scientific and Industrial Research-Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine (CSIR-IIIM)**. Lavender farming has helped many farmers to earn a higher income and to become more financially stable.

6th June

The government has given **permission** to **2000 Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS)** to open special stores called **Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras** all over India. These stores are a part of **Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana** started by the **Department of Pharmaceuticals** under the **Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilisers** in **November 2008**. The purpose of these stores is to **sell good quality medicines at low prices to everyone, especially people living in villages**. This helps to reduce **healthcare costs** for everyone.

8th June

The **Indian Navy** took part in a special event that marked the **130th anniversary** of the **struggle against apartheid**. **Mahatma Gandhi**, a **great leader**, started a **fight** against a system called apartheid on **7th June 1893** at the **Pietermaritzburg Railway Station in South Africa**. To honour this event, a big ship named **INS Trishul** from the Indian Navy went to **Durban, South Africa**. This visit also celebrates the **30-year friendship** between **India and South Africa**.

10th June

IIT Kanpur has made a special **tractor** that runs on a fuel called **Dimethyl Ether (DME)**. It is the first of its kind in **India**. This tractor's engine is better than regular **diesel engines** because it produces **less pollution** and **works** more efficiently. A group called **Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB)**, which is part of the **Department of Science and Technology** supported IIT Kanpur in creating this tractor. This project also supports a program called the '**Methanol Economy**' by **NITI Ayog**. The aim of this program is to **reduce India's oil imports** and to **lower the pollution** that **harms** the environment.

12th June

- 126th birth anniversary** of **Ram Prasad Bismil** was celebrated. He was a **brave** freedom fighter who **fought** against the **British rule**. He is remembered for both his **courage** and **poems**. He was among the most notable Indian freedom fighters who made India's freedom possible.

- The **World Squash Federation (WSF)** has chosen **Chennai, Tamil Nadu** to hold the **2023 Squash World Cup**. In this tournament, there will be **eight teams** from different parts of the **world playing in Chennai**. The teams are from **Australia, Colombia, Egypt, Hong Kong (China), India, Japan, Malaysia and South Africa**.

13th June

- The **first Janjatiya Khel Mahotsav**, organised by **KIIT in Odisha**, successfully ended with the **participation of around 5,000 tribal athletes and 1,000 officials from 26 states**. The event, supported by the **Odisha Government and the Union Ministry of Culture**, aimed to **celebrate and promote tribal sports and unity**. Karnataka performed well and **secured the second position overall, excelling in Kabaddi and Volleyball**. The event focused on bringing together **sports and culture, tribal communities and sports**, as well as the blending of **tradition and modernity**.

16th June

The **High Courts of Allahabad and Delhi** have recognised the **right to change one's name** as an **essential part** of the '**Right to Life**' under **Article 21** of the **Indian Constitution**. In a recent case, the **Delhi High Court** allowed **two brothers** to change their **surname to escape caste discrimination**. The courts **emphasised** that the **right to one's identity** is inherent in the **Right to Life**. The courts considered the right to change names as a **form of freedom of speech and expression**, which should not be unreasonably restricted by the **state**.

19th June

The **Ministry of Culture** has announced that the **Gandhi Peace Prize for 2021** will be given to **Gita Press, Gorakhpur**. This is a significant honour that acknowledges Gita Press' remarkable contributions to society, economy, and politics through a **non-violent approach inspired by Mahatma Gandhi**. The **Gandhi Peace Prize, established by the government in 1995** as a tribute to Gandhi's principles, has recognised many exceptional individuals and organisations for their remarkable work towards **peace and progress**.

24th June

Jammu and Kashmir's diverse wildlife has been given a wonderful addition with the **official recognition** of the **Blue Pansy (Junonia Orithya)** as the **region's official butterfly**. This important announcement, made by **Dheeraj Gupta, Principal Secretary to the Government for the Department of Forest, Ecology and Environment**, is a significant move towards **conserving and safeguarding the natural beauty** of this area. By designating the **Blue Pansy** as the official butterfly, efforts can be focused on **preserving its habitat** and **promoting awareness** about the rich **biodiversity of Jammu and Kashmir**.

SURAT CITY: NEW GUINNESS WORLD RECORD

The **Yoga Day** event with this year's theme '**Yoga for Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam**' (**One Earth, One Family, One Future**) organised on **21st June 2023**, in **Surat city, Gujarat** set a new **Guinness World Record** for the largest gathering of people for a **yoga session** at one place with **1.53 lakh people joining** the program. All the **participants** were given **wristbands** with a **QR Code** which was **scanned** at the time of **entry**.



Guinness World Records has confirmed that **1.53 lakh people** gathered here for the **yoga session**, **beating** the previous **record set in 2018** in **Kota city, Rajasthan** where **1,00,984 people** participated in **Yoga Day** celebration at one place. After this event, **representatives** of the **Guinness Book of World Records** handed over a **Guinness World Record certificate** to **Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel**.

ICE-FREE CONDITIONS OF ARCTIC OCEAN

A recent international study published in the **renowned journal, 'Nature Communications'** suggests that the **Arctic Ocean** known for its **vast ice sheet** could become **ice-free** during the **summer months** if the **world keeps increasing greenhouse gas emissions** (mainly caused by **burning fossil fuels**) at its current speed. This can be **postponed** until the **2050s** if **greenhouse emissions** are **reduced** by **human effort**.



This **decline** in **Arctic sea ice** has **dangerous effects** on **local communities and wildlife**, including **polar bears and walrus**. The **loss** of **Arctic sea ice** further **disrupts** the delicate **balance** of the **Earth's climate**, further leading to **global warming**. The **reduction** of **sea ice** can also result in more **frequent extreme weather events** such as **severe cold waves, heat waves, and heavy rainfalls** all **across the Earth**.

MV EMPRESS: INDIA'S FIRST INTERNATIONAL CRUISE VESSEL

India launched its **first international luxurious cruise ship**, the **MV Empress**, from **Chennai to Sri Lanka** on **6th June 2023**. The **cruise ship** carried **750 passengers** and visited **three ports—Hambantota, Trincomalee and Kankesanthurai** in **Sri Lanka** during its **five-day journey**. The **MV Empress** service was **launched** from **Chennai's International Cruise Terminal** at a cost of **₹ 17.21 crore**.



The passengers can **enjoy luxurious facilities, entertainment and an excellent view** of the sea during the **cruise ride**. With a **rich culture and heritage** around our coastal region, the **government** has **planned** to **popularise cruise tourism** in **India**. It plans to build **three new international cruise ports** by **2024**, with the **number of cruise ships** expected to **rise** from **208 in 2023 to 500 in 2030 and 1100 by 2047**.

NASA'S SPACE GARDEN

NASA astronauts have **successfully cultivated a space garden**, showing the **possibility of growing fresh food** in the **space beyond the boundaries of Earth**. **NASA** studied the effects of **zero gravity** on **vegetable growth**. The **red leaf lettuce plants** were **grown in special pods**. These pods had '**pillows**' (soil containing **fertilisers** and **vacuum sealed**).



Light was provided to these plants using **red, blue and green LED lights**. **Astronauts** can now grow their **own lettuce** on the **International Space Station**. This experience is **important to develop food sources** for long term **missions** to the **Moon, Mars and beyond**. **Studying plant growth in space** provides valuable knowledge on **cultivating crops outside the Earth**.

1. Eat **wholegrains, lentils and beans**, and plenty of **fresh fruits and vegetables**.

3. Avoid **sugary drinks and processed** (canned/bottled) **fruit juices**.
4. Limit **salt intake** to **one teaspoon** a day.

CHANDRAYAAN-3 SUCCESSFULLY LANDS ON MOON'S SOUTH POLE

India became the first country in the world to soft-land Chandrayaan-3 on 23rd August 2023 at 6:04 pm on the Moon's South Pole, a region that has never been explored before. India becomes the fourth country after United States, Russia and China to successfully land a spacecraft on the Moon. All of the previous spacecrafts (landed on the Moon) have landed in the region near the Moon's equator.



Chandrayaan-3 landed on Moon's South Pole. It faced many challenges. The South Pole lies in a completely dark region without sunlight and temperatures can go below 230 degree Celsius. This creates difficulty in the operation of instruments. Landing on Moon's equator is easier and safer. Here, sunlight is present, providing a regular supply of solar energy to solar-powered instruments.

Chandrayaan-3 is expected to operate for at least one lunar day (14 Earth days) on the lunar surface. Lander and Rover modules are well equipped with advanced scientific instruments. The Pragyan rover can move around the landing site within a radius of 500 meters, conducting experiments and sending data and images to the lander. The Vikram lander will relay the data and images to the orbiter, which will then transmit them to Earth. These instruments are designed to conduct comprehensive experiments to study about Moon's Soil, Moon's atmosphere, exploration for water and potential resource reservoirs. We salute the scientists and engineers of Chandrayaan-3 who made us proud to be Indians.

India To Host The G20 Summit 2023

G20 (Group of Twenty) New Delhi Summit 2023 is scheduled to take place in Bharat Mandapam International Exhibition Convention Centre (IECC), Pragati Maidan, New Delhi on 9th and 10th September 2023. The G20 was established in 1999 with the aim of bringing together both advanced and emerging economies to address international economic and financial issues.

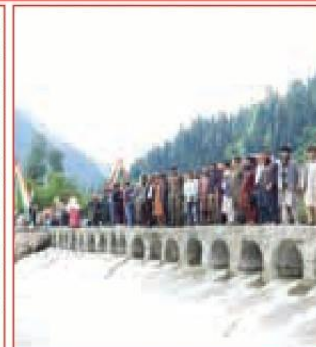


The G20 countries, in alphabetical order, are: Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, European Union, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Turkey, United Kingdom, United States. India's special invitee guest countries are Bangladesh, Egypt, Mauritius, Netherlands, Nigeria, Oman, Singapore, Spain and UAE.

The theme of India's G20 Presidency is – 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam' or 'One Earth · One Family · One Future'. G20 Logo draws inspiration from the vibrant colours of India's National Flag – saffron, white green and blue. It represents the blue planet Earth with the lotus, India's National Flower, that reflects growth among challenges. India holds the Presidency of the G20 from 1st December, 2022 to 30th November 2023. India hosted over 200 meetings in over 50 cities across 32 different workstreams and offered G20 delegates and guests a glimpse of India's rich cultural heritage and unique Indian experience. G20 represents approximately 85% of the world's gross domestic product (GDP) and two-thirds of its population.

INDIAN ARMY DEDICATES 'BHAGAT BRIDGE' ON 77TH INDEPENDENCE DAY

The Indian Army inaugurated the 'Bhagat Bridge' in Danna Village, the last village on the Line of Control in the Machhal Sector of Jammu and Kashmir, on 15th August 2023. It was India's 77th Independence Day. This 115-feet long bridge is named in memory of Veer Chakra awardee, Late Major Bhagat Singh, who bravely defended this sector during the 1965 war.

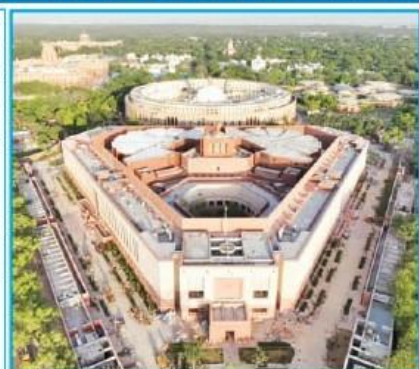


'Bhagat Bridge' connects the remote Danna Village to the rest of the region. The village of Danna is known as Bhagat Village, in the memory of the freedom fighter Late Major Bhagat Singh. The Indian Army engineers worked extremely hard facing adverse weather conditions, including heavy rains, while constructing the bridge across Machchal Nala.

The Bhagat bridge dedication ceremony was attended by villagers, including children, women and elders from seven nearby villages. They expressed their thanks for the infrastructure that would improve education, healthcare access and tourism prospects in the region. It enables children to attend school more easily additionally helps the movement of the sick and elderly to healthcare facilities. It symbolizes the Indian Army's dedication to defending the borders and contributing to the welfare of the local communities, thereby strengthening the bonds with the people of Jammu and Kashmir.

INDIA'S NEW PARLIAMENT BUILDING

The New Parliament House situated on Rafi Marg, New Delhi, has 888 seats in the Lok Sabha chamber and 384 seats in the Rajya Sabha chamber. It has a built-up in area of approx. 65,000 sq m. and is triangular in shape. The Lok Sabha hall is based on the peacock theme, representing India's national bird. The Rajya Sabha hall is based on the lotus theme, symbolising India's national flower.



The construction of India's new Parliament building with increased seating capacity for the members of parliament, improved infrastructure, advanced technology, earthquake-resistance and all other safety measures mark a significant milestone in the nation's journey towards efficient governance representing the culture, pride and spirit of the entire nation.

HUDA CITY CENTRE TO CYBER CITY METRO

The government on 7th June 2023 approved the extension of the Metro Network from HUDA City Centre to Cyber City in Gurugram, a metro track of 28.5 km with 27 new stations will be built over the next four years at an estimated cost of ₹ 5,452.7 crore. The metro line will connect Old Gurugram with New Gurugram. The main metro line, from HUDA City Centre to Cyber City, will be 26.65 km in length with 26 stations.



A 'spur' or extension line will be connected from Basai Village to Dwarka Expressway, (a 1.85 km metro track with one station) along with a link to the Indian Railways and Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi. Gurugram, with an estimated population of 25 lakh, is expected to have almost 5.34 lakh metro passengers, 7.26 lakh by 2031, 8.81 lakh by 2041 and 10.70 lakh by 2051.
